

Fees in the areas of family reunification, studies and work

From 1 January 2011 you will normally have to pay a fee for submitting an application for a residence permit, an appeal or a request to reopen a case in the areas of family reunification, studies and work.

How to apply

Please follow this procedure:

- 1. Create a case order ID on www.newtodenmark.dk/fee
- 2. Pay the fee (unless you are exempt from paying the fee)
- 3. Submit your application, appeal or request

You must create a **case order ID** on newtodenmark.dk/fee. Your must state the 8-digit case order ID when you pay the fee and when you submit your application/ appeal/ request to reopen a case. The purpose of the case order ID is to digitally connect the application with the payment made.

If you wish to submit more than one application/ appeal/ request to reopen a case you must create a case order ID for each case. If you wish to submit an application for family reunification for more than one person (e.g. your spouse and children) you must submit an application for each person. Consequently, you must create a case order ID and pay a fee for the case of each person.

Fees can be paid online with a Dankort (a Danish credit card), online from a Danish internet bank, by international bank transfer or in a Danish bank or post office. Fees cannot be paid to the Service Centre, the Integration Ministry or the police.

The fee must be paid by the time the application, appeal or request is submitted. If you pay the fee later your application/ appeal/ request will be rejected. Consequently, it is important that you enclose a receipt for payment of the fee by credit card or international bank transfer as documentation for the time of payment.
